I started my development journey on my 12th birthday, at that time programming in BASIC. Since then I became passionate about creating software and working with hardware. Since 1996 I've gained professional IT experience, mainly working as a consultant for companies in many projects, delivering the highest possible quality. Although skilled in-depth in Lotus Notes technologies, my main focus shifted towards web development projects (B2B), mobile application development and social projects. As I'm very eager to learn the newest technologies to keep up-to-date my technical knowledge, I'm constantly educating myself in new programming languages, tools and frameworks (Xamarin, Android Studio, Eclipse, Phonegap, .NET, EasyEclipse, Worklight, ...). In 2011, as development tasks were moved towards China, I first became Project Manager for customer projects (Skillteam, KPN, ...) and then changed towards Client facing IT Architect, working for customers like KPN, European Commission, BCRS, Dexia, ... In this project I was the lead of the Chinese development team (~15 people).

In 2009 I moved to the Inside Sales department, where I started modelling in a Domino based middleware WSE (Web Solution Enabler) for creating B2B applications for many IBM customers. Later, the underlying layer was changed from Notes towards Websphere.

I joined IBM via a merger of PwC Consulting. I started in the Global Services department where I mainly developed internal Lotus Notes applications and performed Domino administration tasks. I created technical courses and educated them in class-rooms towards non-technical internal employees (groups >100 people, one-on-one or team based).

I was responsible for internal communication (education, ...).

I performed all-round IT tasks, as of which eg. Development for many purposes (C++, barcode scanners, ...)

I was involved in migration and integration of other mergers with IBM (P&G, Candle, Fitech, Deutsche Bank, Inbev). I led some projects in the Strategic Outsourcing team.
