### European Commission - eROM

Project Description: Result Oriented Monitoring (ROM).

The ROM system provides the European Union with a wide range of quantitative and qualitative data on the performance of the development projects and programmes which receive EC financial support. ROM covers all regions and all countries that fall under the EU external cooperation activities. It is split in two regions: East & South. The total reports handled exceeded 2,000 units in 2010. In 2012, 91 Missions and 417 Projects were handled with ROM. eROM (now at v3) provides a workflow and document management with advanced analytical capabilities based on an IBM middleware on top of Websphere.

Contribution: I am the IT Architect for this project, working together with the Project Manager, Sales representative, the EU team (internal IBM + external) and the Chinese (Dalian) team (development team ~ 15 people) . I'm leading the team of developers in Dalian. I created the architecture of this new B2B application, including mockups, swimlanes, workflows and Electronic Design Documents (using IBM methodology),...

With the tool we achieved following results :

- Decrease of complexity with one integrated workflow and document management application
- Reduce costs by centralising management and follow up
- Decrease of errors with better tooling
- Increase efficiency by matching the experts with the missions and by structuring the feedback mechanism within the ROM.
- Increase customer satisfaction by bringing fast and accurate feedback to the decision makers, allowing smarter execution

### KPN - eSOW

Project Description: The Electronic Statement of Work is a web based workflow solution provided by IBM to facilitate the creation, negotiation and signing of SOWs between IBM and our customers. The project initially started for the company KPN (Netherlands). The tool helps the customer and IBM to manage the workflow of SOW requests resulting in stronger client relationship, efficiency and reduction of cost. One tool created easier business for all.

For KPN, the revenue is about 12 million euro per year, including around 150 SOW request per year. At this moment, new customers (ABN AMRO and ING) are being integrated into the tool.

Contribution: I am the main IT Architect for this project, working together with the Project Manager, Sales representative, customer teams (internal IBM and external) and the Chinese (Dalian) development team (~5 people).

I have to make sure to perform the full solution deployment management including user education, solution maintenance and support. Therefore I am closely teaming with the KPN (and now other customers) team, development and project teams.

I created project schedules and worked together with Dalian team for the architecture of the tool.
